What is a Salaried Position?

Salary: A salary is a fixed regular payment, typically paid on a monthly or biweekly basis but often expressed as an annual sum, made by an employer to an employee, especially a professional or white-collar worker.

Gross Salary


Gross income is all a person's income, from all sources, before any deductions.

Net Salary

Net salary is the amount of take-home pay remaining after all withholding and deductions have been removed from a person's salary.

Rounding Money

Round Cents: Round to the hundredths place



Salaried Positions: Calculating Paychecks

TOTAL SALARY: \$50,000 per year

Weekly: Divide by 52

Bi-weekly: Divide by 26

Semi-monthly: Divide by 24

Monthly: Divide by 12

Quarterly: 4 pay periods

Semi-annually: 2 pay periods

Salaried Positions: Calculating Paychecks
